DEFERRED ACTION FOR CHILDHOOD ARRIVALS

What is DACA?

Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) is a U.S. immigration program that grants protection from deportation and work permits to undocumented individuals that came to the U.S. as children.

WHAT DOES DACA NOT INCLUDE?

It does NOT include financial aid, Medicaid and other government benefits. Does not grant a path to citizenship or permanent residency.

THERE ARE OVER 650,000 DACA RECPIENTS IN THE U.S.

Estimated as of April 2021

REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Under 31 years old in 2012
- In the U.S. before turning 16 years old.
- Residing continuously in the U.S. since 2007.
- Enrolled in school, hold a high school diploma, GED or be a veteran.
- Without lawful status in 2012.
- Not convicted of a felony or misdemeanors. Doesn't pose a threat to national security or public safety.
- Present in the U.S. on June, 15th 2012.
- Living in the U.S. at time of application.

WHO ARE THE DACA **RECIPIENTS?**

A survey of Dreamers in 2019 (4) showed that because of DACA:







- of those in school, 83% are pursuing a bachelor's degree or higher



- 58% reported moved to a job with better pay



- 48% moved to a job with better working conditions

HR 6: THE DREAM AND PROMISE ACT

HR6 would create a three-step path to citizenship for DACA recipients, individuals with Deferred Enforced Departure, Temporary Protected Status Holders, and other eligible immigrant youth.



QUALIFICATIONS:

- Entered the U.S. before January 1st, 2021
- Were 18 or under at entry into the U.S.
- Have continuously resided since arrival
- Meet an education, work or military service requirement
- Pass government and background security checks

WHY THIS IS IMPORTANT NOW

55% of Utahns support a path to citizenship for DACA recipients. Many of the individuals affected are essential workers, family members and neighbors.
